




Christmas List Devotion

Christmas List Devotion

Did you know that God gives us gifts? Read I Peter 4:10, Ecclesiastes 3:13, James 1:17, Eph. 2:8

What kinds of gifts are mentioned in these verses?

How are these different than the gifts you want for Christmas or the gifts we give to others?

Did you know that when you pray, you can ask God for things that you need or want? He said for us to make our requests known to him. Write Philippians 4:6

How does God answer our prayers (requests)? Sometimes God sends people, sometimes he gives us ideas, and sometimes He gives us a better desire so we can match His will. Read Matthew 6:9-13 and say the prayer together with your family. Notice how Jesus shows us how to ask God to help us have His desires? Write that part of the verse below:

What about other people? Did you know that God might use YOU to answer another persons prayer? Yep! Would you like God to use you to help others? Maybe you have a talent or skill that could help others. Maybe you have a special idea that God has given you. If not, pray and ask God to use you and give you ideas on ways to give to other people this Christmas season.
